#### **Overview**

- National non-profit organization dedicated to:
  - Empowering physicians to lead in the delivery of high quality, cost-efficient health care
  - Strengthening the physician-patient relationship
  - Informing national healthcare policy by giving a voice to physicians nationwide
  - Supporting practicing physicians as they work to sustain their medical practices and navigate healthcare reform



## **2017 Accomplishments**

- Ongoing grant administration in the areas of physician leadership and physician wellbeing, as well as projects centered around primary care initiatives and addressing social determinants of health.
- Began planning preliminary phases of our biennial national physician survey (2018)
- Conducted and released the results of the 2017 patient survey
- Planned and led the Foundation's 2017 Karl Altenburger, MD Physician Leadership Academy at Brandeis University
- Increased grant making substantially, predicted proposals to exceed \$6M
- Awarded TMA and FMA \$500K each for disaster relief
- Funded a new featured series in Health Affairs, The Practice of Medicine
- Wrote and published a number blogs for Forbes



#### Patient Survey Results Issued Oct 2017

- Surveyed healthcare consumers to evaluate attitudes on:
  - Physician-patient relationship
  - Cost of healthcare
  - Social determinants
  - Lifestyle issues
- Media outreach underway targeting variety of national and trade healthcare reporters



#### **Compelling Survey Findings**

- 95 percent report satisfaction with their primary care physician
- Over 90 percent believe physicians should advocate for patients
- 75 percent concerned about their ability to pay for medical treatment should they
  get sick or injured (compared to 62 percent in 2015)
- 69 percent believe insurance companies have the greatest influence in impacting treatment options
  - Contradicts with whom consumers (87 percent) feel the true influencer should be physicians
- Physicians and consumers feel several other institutions and organizations are key decision-makers, including:
  - Pharmaceutical and medical device companies (49 percent)
  - Congress (41 percent)
  - Physicians (31 percent)
  - State government (31 percent)
- 57 percent feel physicians rely more on what the computer screen tells them versus the patient

### **Physician Well-Being**

- Physician well-being was a large focus for the Foundation in 2017 where we used our platform to spotlight its risk to the future of medicine and need to address head on
  - Sponsored and spoke at the American Conference on Physician Health
  - Awarded grants for wellness programs and research to Mayo Clinic and Massachusetts General Hospital
  - Authored Forbes post on physician burnout
  - Bolstered relevant content via social media



#### **Grantees**

- Awarded more than \$46 million in grants since 2005
- Invested nearly \$6 million in 2017 to date
- Many of the 2017 grants focused on physician leadership, burnout and well-being

- Facilitated annual Karl M.
   Altenburger Leadership
   Academy at Brandeis
   University
- Focused on developing physician's leadership skills, empowering them to foster change in a complex healthcare system
